



Combermere Dog Policy

**WE WELCOME DOGS AT STONE LODGE.
FOR EVERYBODY'S SAFETY WE WOULD BE OBLIGED IF OWNERS WOULD ABIDE BY
THE FOLLOWING RULES.**

- We permit one large or two small dogs to stay in Stone Lodge and they **must** be fully house trained. The Lodge is quite near to a public road so owners are responsible for making sure the entrance gates to the property are securely closed. There is a large orchard garden where dogs may run free.
- Dogs **must** be kept on leads when going down the drive and all other walks available to our guests on the estate.
- You may not leave your dog/dogs unattended in the cottage at any time.
- Please keep them downstairs and off furniture, bedspreads and bed linen for hygienic reasons.
- You will find a pooch pack in your cottage which contains a sofa cover, bowl and treat and we provide bags in order that they do not soil the garden areas or other public areas.
- There is an excellent walk from the cottage which is accessed by walking down the main estate drive. There are maps in the cottage to guide you.
- **The Woodland Walk** is two miles long and is accessed by walking down the main estate drive and turning right at the Gothic House. It is fully signed and goes through the parkland and ancient woods. It crosses the farmed area of the estate where there may be animals in the fields. Dogs must be kept on the leads at all times on this walk.
- We have earmarked certain areas ie the Pleasure Garden and Garden Wood, where dogs are allowed to roam without leads. These areas are only permitted for you when we do not have an event taking place, you will be informed of any events taking place via the arrival letter in your cottage.
